NOMINEE: Robby Bell

HOMETOWN: Menifee CA

Robby Bell is a legend in the making on two wheels. With a love for motorcycles that began on a 50cc bike at age four, Robby entered his first race when he was 16. He quickly gained success, taking overall honors in the Baja 1000 in 2007, 2008 and 2014. Robby also has a WORCS championship to his name, winning the title in 2013. He has a successful year on track for the 2016 WORCS series, winning the first two events of the season.



NOMINEE: Justin Lambert

HOMETOWN: Bakersfield CA

It's been quite a year for Justin and his Cognito Motorsports team. He won the long-course Walker Evans Racing Desert Racing Championship and his Best in the Desert class at the same event in Laughlin earlier this year, claiming the title as reigning UTV World Champion. Justin is dominating the Best in the Desert series in the 1000 Production UTV Class in 2016, with five straight wins, including the Class and Overall win at Vegas to Reno.



NOMINEE: Sara Price

HOMETOWN: Canyon Lake CA

Sara is a Professional Motocross and Supercross racer who has made her mark by not only making history in her racing endeavors, but also in the Motocross Industry. She is the first ever factory supported female racer under Monster Energy Kawasaki and a medalist in X-Games. Sara is still a regular on the motocross track, but has also become a champion off road race car driver and UTV Champion in the Terracross Series. Sara is the first female driver in Stadium Super trucks in 2016. As a young business lady and role model, Sara is always striving for the best and giving back to her community.



NOMINEE: Toby Price

HOMETOWN: New South Wales, Australia

A former Australian Junior Motocross Champion, Cody began his professional career at 16. In 2009 he was named Rookie of the Year by *Australian Dirt Bike* magazine. Cody dominated in enduro and desert from 2010 to 2014, despite frequent serious race injuries. Cody entered his first Dakar Rally in 2015, winning a stage and finishing third overall. 2016 has been Cody's year. He has won Dakar, the Abu Dhabi Desert Challenge and the Finke Desert Race, where he competed in both cars and bikes. Flying back and forth to complete each leg, he finished second in cars and won the bike division for a record-equaling fifth time.



NOMINEE: Colton Udall

HOMETOWN: San Clemente CA

"Colton Udall cruised to the overall Motorcycle win at the Rosarito Beach 20th SCORE Desert Challenge" was the latest headline on Colton Udall, but it wasn't his first and sure isn't going to be his last. Colton has been racing deep in the heart of Baja for many years now and is known for his winning streak in some of the most prestigious races such as the Baja 500 and Baja 1000. Udall has also placed 1st in the 24 Hours of Glen Helen. He is the Rider/Owner of Team 0x Motorsports.
