NOMINEE: Lalo Laguna

HOMETOWN: Mexicali, Baja California

Lalo drives the RPM Trophy Truck and is a SCORE Class 1 driver. He was the overall winner in the 2015 SCORE Baja Sur 500. Lalo is has had success in many classes and series, including the 1500 Class win at the 2014 Henderson 250 and the 7200 Class win at the 2012 Silver State. He has won SCORE Championships in Class 4 and Class 6, and finished second in a SCORE Class 9 Championship. Lalo has won both the SCORE Baja 500 and Baja 1000. Lalo received a TOYOTA Milestone Award in 2011.



NOMINEE: Andy McMillin

HOMETOWN: San Diego CA

Andy McMillin is a five time Tecate SCORE Baja 1000 champion in Trophy Truck class. The third generation off road racer is the youngest male to win the prestigious title. Andy McMillin just piloted his #31 Trick Truck to an overall win at the 2016 BITD Vegas to Reno race. Andy may have taken some years off to start a family and work at the family business, but this future legend is working his way back to racing full time and will be hunting down another Baja 1000 win in November.



NOMINEE: Luke McMillin

HOMETOWN: San Diego CA

Luke began racing in the 1600 limited buggy class, where he finished consistently on the podium. In 2010, he won the 1600 class championship in the SCORE series. He backed it up with a second straight championship in 2011; winning both the Baja 500 and Baja 1000. In 2012, Luke moved up into an unlimited class one car in the SCORE series. That year he won all three Baja races, the San Felipe 250, the Baja 500, and the Baja 1000. Luke is quickly advancing up the ranks after moving up to Trick Truck in the McMillin Racing #83.



NOMINEE: Cody Parkhouse

HOMETOWN: Long Beach CA

Cody drives the #127 Class 1 JIMCO buggy. 2016 has been a good year for the Parkhouse Team. Cody has won the BITD Mint 400, Laughlin Desert Classic, Vegas to Reno and is currently leading the points in BITD Class 1500. Last year he won the SCORE Baja 500 and was on the podium in every BITD race except Henderson, winning the BITD Class 1500 points championship. He also won the 2012 and 2013 SCORE Class 1 championships.



NOMINEE: Jason Voss

HOMETOWN: Cupertino CA

Jason grew up riding motorcycles, and started racing trucks in 2005. No stranger to winning, Jason is the three-peat Vegas To Reno Trick Truck Champion from 2013-2015. The young gun also has held the Best In The Desert Trick Truck Championship title for two years. Teaming up with Rob MacCachren and Andy McMillin, Voss also claimed the title of 2014 Baja 1000 Champion. Jason is looking to finishing out the 2016 BITD season in winning fashion.
