NOMINEE: Jerett Brooks

HOMETOWN: San Diego CA

Jerett Brooks is just one year out of high school. His team travels the country racing his #77 ProLite, earning the TORC Series Championship in 2014. He has also competed in Stadium Super Trucks and The X Games. Brooks has had success in the Lucas Oil Off Road Racing Series, where he finished second in points in 2015. He has nailed down a remarkable five wins this season in LOORRS and is on his way to the championship.



NOMINEE: CJ Greaves

HOMETOWN: Green Bay WI

CJ is the son of Johnny Greaves. CJ has been very successful since he joined the sport, racing and winning in the TORC Series, Pro Buggy and Pro Lite. CJ has since had three back to back championships in Pro2 (2014-2016), along with two back to back Pro4 championships. (2015-2016). He was voted 2012 Dirtsports Rookie driver of the year, and 2015 Dirtsports Short Course Driver of the year. Multiple AMSOIL Cup champion, and a multiple Crandon World Cup Champion.



NOMINEE: Darren Hardesty Jr

HOMETOWN: Ramona CA

Darren "Hot Sauce" Hardesty Jr. is a third generation racer who is making his own mark in off road racing. Working his way up the ladder from Kart Classes, where he was named "Rookie of the Year", to Pro Buggy class in the Lucas Series. He earned the Rookie of the Year title and a Regional championship, and became the youngest driver to win a Pro class in LOORRS history. In 2016 he has 3 wins in LOORRS and he won the World Championship Title and placed 2nd in the Crandon World Cup. At just 16 years of age, Darren Jr. is already an accomplished racer.



NOMINEE: Kyle LeDuc

HOMETOWN: Temecula CA

Kyle is the son of Hall of Famer Curt LeDuc. He has had great success in the LOORRS Pro4 category, with countless podiums and wins. In 2012 he won his first title as Pro4 Champion. Not only is Kyle one of the best in off road, he also prides himself in being hands on and elbows deep in dirt and grease. Kyle has built his own race trucks since he first set wheels on the track as a professional. Kyle has the mind of an engineer and builds his own race vehicles from the ground up with his own two hands.



NOMINEE: Bryce Menzies

HOMETOWN: Las Vegas NV

At 27 years old, Bryce Menzies has quickly risen to elite status in off road truck racing as one of the most seasoned and accomplished champions in the sport. Bryce is a 3-Time TORC Pro2 Champion as well as 2nd Overall LOORRS Pro2 and 3rd Overall LOORRS Pro4. Menzies is also the Red Bull Frozen Rush Champion competing against the best of the best. He has numerous wins in the LOORRS 2016 season in both Pro2 and Pro4 class. Outside of Short Course, Bryce earned three Baja 500 victories in four years.
