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OFF-ROAD MOTORSPORTS HALL OF FAME NOMINATION WORKSHEET

The Off-Road Motorsports Hall of Fame (ORMHOF) has been established to recognize and honor those individuals and organizations whose lifelong contributions to off-road motorsports have set a standard for others to follow.

Thank you for your interest in nominating a candidate for the Off-Road Motorsports Hall of Fame. Since 1978, only 148 individuals have been selected to receive the off-road industry's highest honor. The road to induction begins with the Nomination Packet. Here are a few tips to make the process go smoothly:

- 2026 Nominations will be accepted online only, between March 1 and March 31.
- The link to the Nomination Packet will be available on March 1st [HERE](#)
- Review the [Nomination Procedures and Criteria for Induction](#), and confirm that your nominee is not already one of the [current 148 inductees in the Off-Road Motorsports Hall of Fame](#).
- Nominations are accepted from current ORMHOF members, partners, and donors. Join or renew [here](#).
- Give yourself plenty of time to compile the required information and complete the Nomination Packet.
- Pro Tip: Compile the information needed for the online Nomination Packet into a Word document for easy editing. When you are satisfied that the information is complete and best represents your nominee, copy and paste into the fields in the online Nomination Packet.
- The voting committee is interested in the **quality** of the nominee, not the **quantity** of information provided.

- Please explain the Nominee's impact on the sport of off-road (maximum 200 words)

- In 200 words or less, please tell us why your nominee should be selected for 2026 ORMHOF induction over other nominees?
- Letters of recommendation from prominent industry representatives (two to five).
- Headshot picture of nominee.
- Resume. Should be one page and include bullet-point timeline of major achievements or accomplishment within the category of nomination. *Achievements or accomplishments should transcend mere race finishes. They should encompass the broader spectrum of impact and contribution to the sport*

IMPORTANT

The quality rather than the quantity of the information provided will help voting committee members evaluate the nominee more fully. They are busy professionals; please be respectful of their time and follow the format. Packets that exceed the size limit will be returned. As you develop your information, pay close attention to sharing the nominee's narrative. Focus on their achievements, and equally as important, what they have given back to the off-road motorsports community.
